Guidelines for authors:

- The abstract should be original and not published or submitted for publishing elsewhere.
- Abstracts up to 3 pages, A4 paper size in MS Word.
- Margins: top, right, left – 2,5 cm; bottom – 3,5 cm.
- Font: Times New Roman, size 14, line spacing – single.
- Title in CAPITAL letters, bold, centered; next line: authors' names, bold, centered; next line – title/academic degree and job position; next line: institution.
- Formulas, tables and pictures (optional) should be prepared with MS Word tools.
- Do not use automatic or manual hyphenation.
- In text references style: e.g. [5, p. 123], where 5 – number of the source in the reference section, 123 – page number (optional).
- References should be listed at the end of the abstract.
- Indicate first author's surname in the attached file's name.
