Graduates of the European Business Law Master's Programme will have enough knowledge and skills to run for positions at leading law firms, at public authorities related to EU, at legal departments of public and private companies engaged in export and import as well as at their associations. Also the graduates will enable to independently analyse the trends of practical application of the EU Law at international and foreign courts, prepare reference materials, recommendations, provide expert advice etc.
