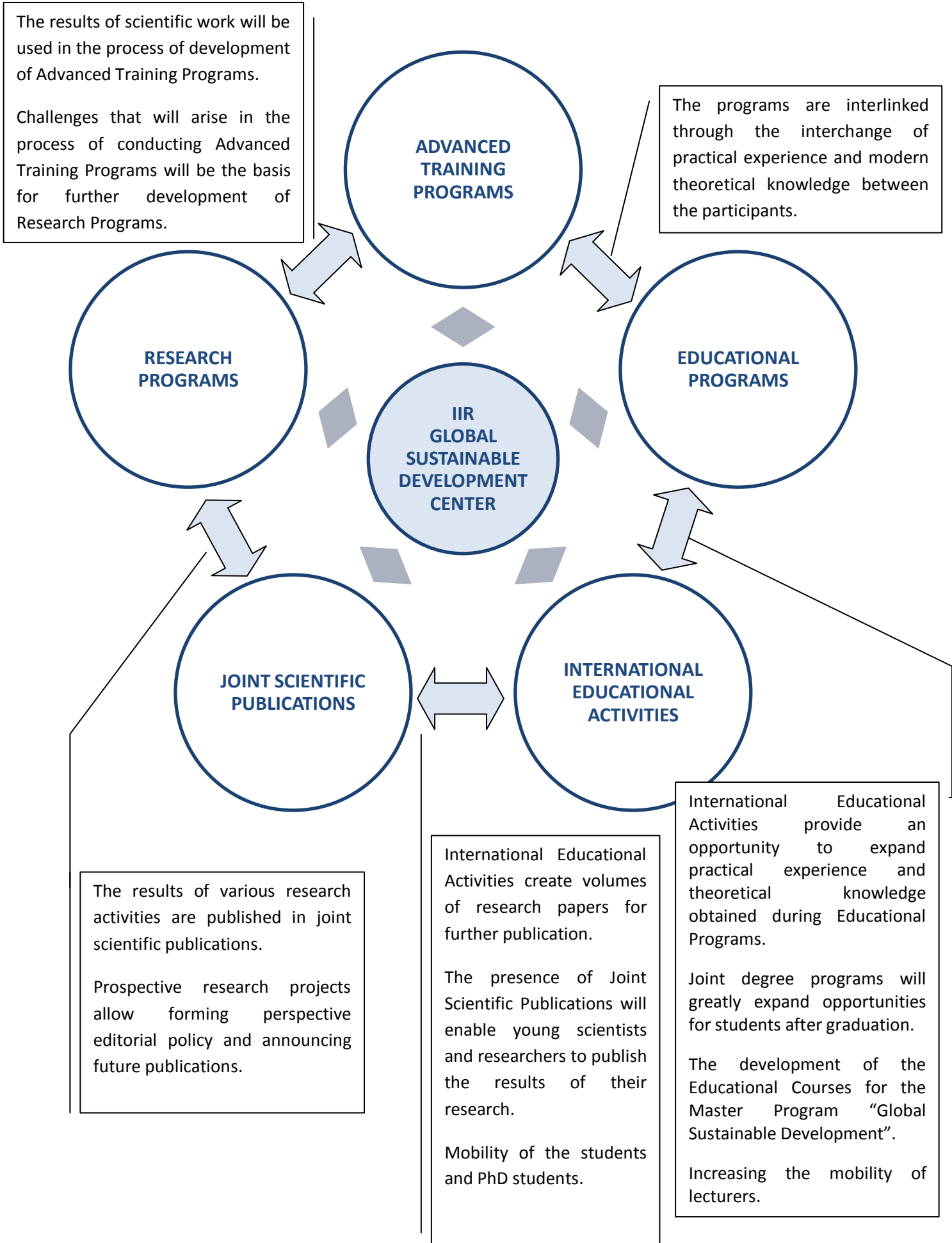
3. INTERNATIONAL EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES:
