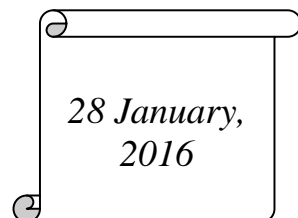

REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS:

- Margins are 2 sm, font Times New Roman (size – 14), interval is 1.
- Use paragraph 1 – do not use TAB button.
- For electronic version of the abstracts use Microsoft Word 98, DOC format.
- To create figures use internal Microsoft Office software, grouped.
- Initials and surnames of authors* –in the upper right corner of the first page, after an empty line - *name of organization where author works*, the city is on the next line.
- Name of the abstract is printed on the next line (use interval 2) in the center in bold font (small letters, size 14).
- Do not put numbers on the pages.
- An example of a reference [4, c. 45] and inverted commas «...».
